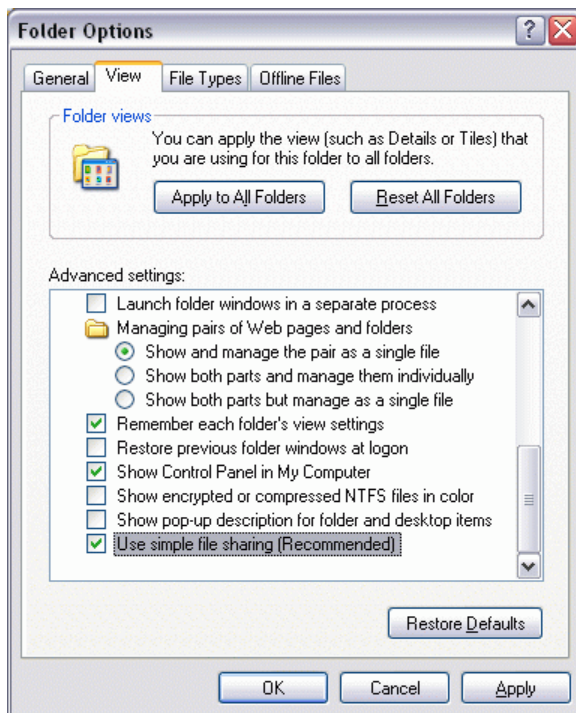


## Windows Permission to Run the Cameleon Client Application

In order for a user to be able to run the Cameleon client application, the user must log in to Windows under a user group that has permission to run the client. To give users the necessary permission, follow the steps below. Perform this procedure on every Cameleon client PC.

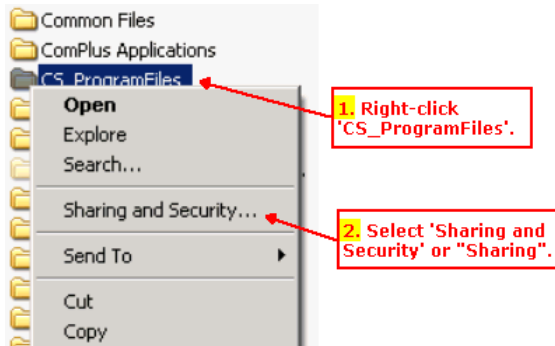
To set the permission:

1. Log in to Windows as a Windows administrator.
2. Open Windows Explorer and browse to the **Program Files** folder.
3. Select **Tools > Folder Options**.  
⇒ The Folder Options dialog box will open.
4. Select the View tab.
5. Scroll down and clear **Use simple file sharing**. This enables you to see the Security tab where you set the permission. If the 'Use simple file sharing' option does not appear in the pop-up menu, proceed to the step 6.



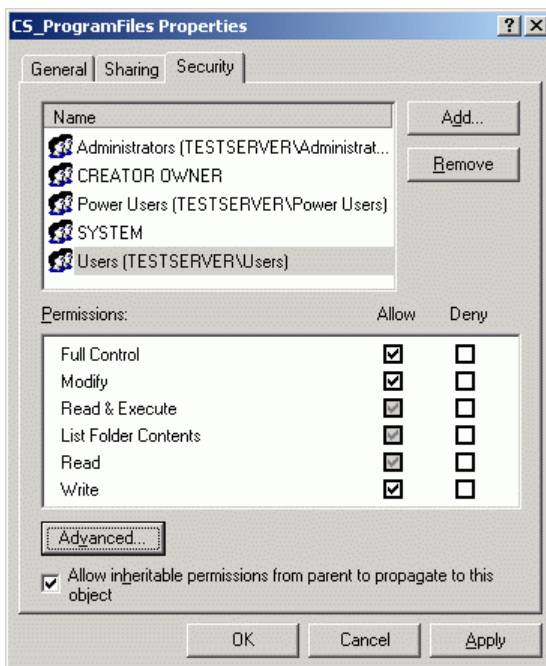
6. Click **OK**.  
⇒ The Folder Options dialog box will close.

7. In Windows Explorer, right-click **CS\_ProgramFiles** and select **Sharing and Security**.



⇒ The CS\_ProgramFiles Properties dialog box will open.

8. Select the Security tab.
9. In the 'Group or User Names' area, select the user or user group you want to give permission to.
10. In the 'Permissions for Users' area, select **Allow Full Control**.



11. Click **OK**.

⇒ The CS\_ProgramFiles Properties dialog box will close.

12. If you disabled simple file sharing in step 5 and you want to re-enable it, you can do so now. When simple file sharing is enabled, the user cannot see the Security tab where permissions are set.
